Show Contract

Contractors operating an Alberta Cattlemen's Penning and Sorting show will be entitled to 35% of all **sanctioned class entry fees**. This includes the Open, #10, #7 and the #5 classes. Any class that is not a regular sanctioned class, or requires less cattle, such as the sorting, the Contractor will be entitled to 25% of the class fee.

The Show Contractor has the Physical and Financial Responsibility for supplying the following:

Arena - The main entry gate for the cattle to enter the arena should be in the center of the arena at the cattle end of the arena. Panels to make a 20 x 20 pen for inside the arena. Alberta Cattlemen's will supply an 8' gate for the back of the inside pen. Pens outside the arena to house the cattle required for the penning. This usually requires 4 to 5 pens with 30 head of cattle in each pen.

Cattle - The Alberta Cattlemen's will advise you a week prior to the show date as to exactly how many animals will be needed. Again we usually require at least 90 head, but may require more depending on the entries. The Contractor will supply feed for the cattle, if they are being trucked in the day before the penning or after the penning. Contractors will make sure all cattle are healthy, two-eyed and workable. 1 or 2 spare animals may be required in case of injury to an animal. Negotiation of the cattle price, with the supplier, is the responsibility of the Contractor.

Trucking of the Cattle - Trucking may be required to and from the arena. Alberta Cattlemen's request that Hartford Insurance is put on cattle being trucked in, as this is usually where injuries occur.

Numbering of Cattle - It is preferred that the cattle are numbered in the morning of the show so that the numbers are as clean as possible. A handling system may be required for this. Alberta Cattlemen's will supply the numbers and glue.

Herd Handlers - These are the people responsible for changing the herd out of the arena every 10 runs. It is important that the herds are used in a numerical order so that all of the animals get used equally. The herd handlers are required to keep the water topped up in all of the cattle pens and if required, occasionally hose down the cattle if the weather is hot.

Concession - This concession can be your own or sub contracted in by you (the Contractor) if you wish.

Water - Watering bowls or tubs are required for each pen of cattle. Also, a water supply for the contestants horses is required (hose, taps, etc.).

The Alberta Cattlemen's will be responsible for the Entries, paper work, Timers, Judges, Secretaries, Class Payouts and the over - all management of the show. For questions please contact your local Director or Contact person.
